

How to make a felt flower

Materials Needed -

Felt

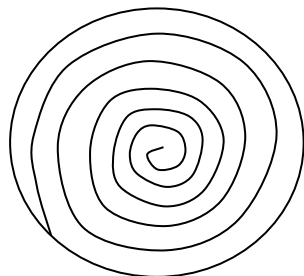
Scissors

Glue

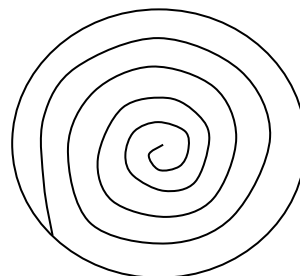


1. Cut out a circle of felt using the template attached or by drawing round a tea plate approx. 20cm diameter.

2. Starting from the edge, cut the felt circle into a spiral. A loose spiral will create taller slimmer flowers whereas a tighter spiral will create shorter fuller flowers. The gaps do not have to be even as this will create the effect of different sized petals.



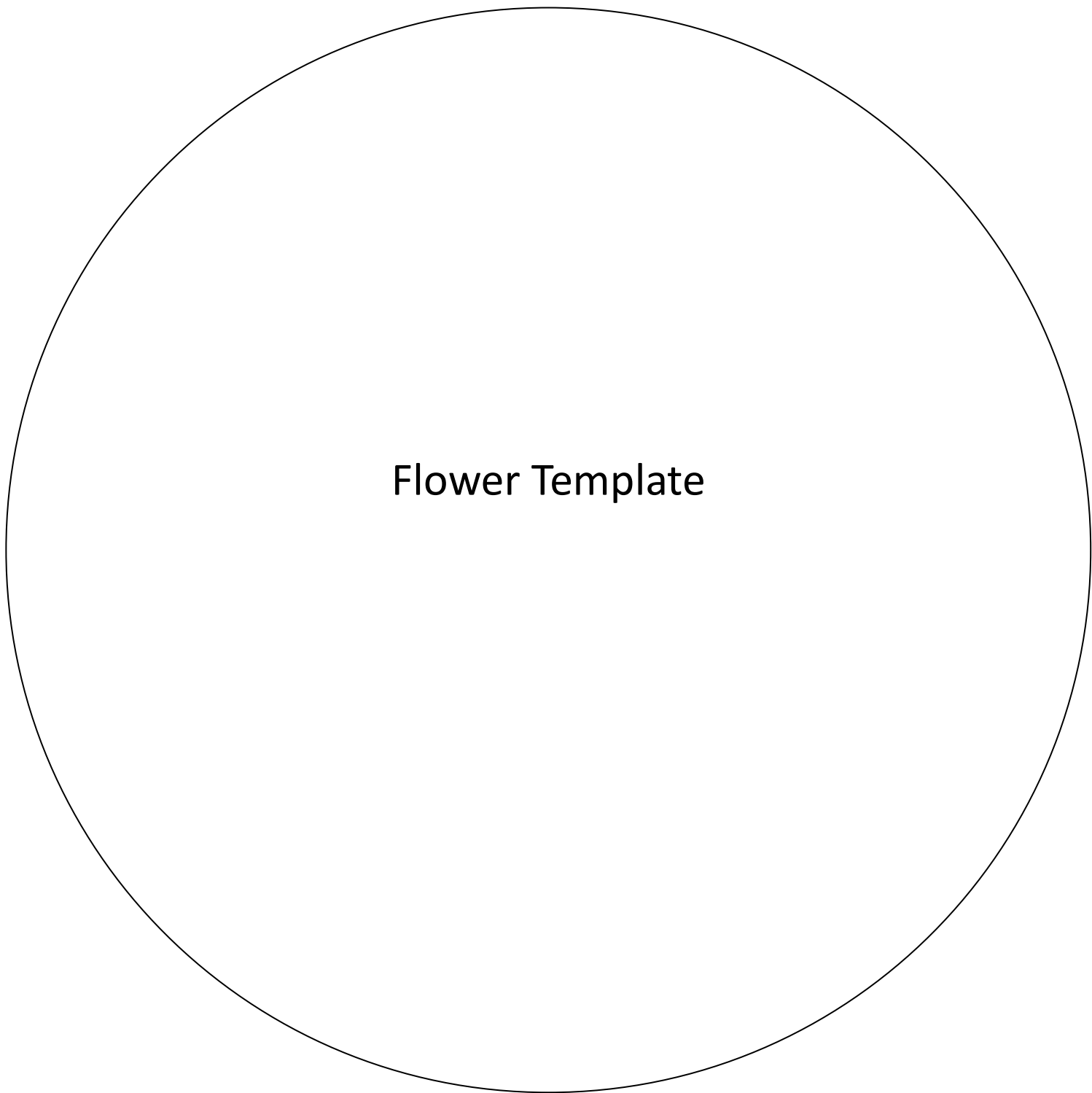
Tight spiral

3. Starting from the centre of the spiral wrap the felt around itself to create your flower shape. Trim off any excess felt to make a flat base. Use a bit of glue to hold flower together.
